Make a 4th of July treat! Red, White & Blue Fruit Pizza:

You will need: strawberries, blueberries, sugar cookies and either icing, whipped cream or Cool Whip.

Step 1: Slice the strawberries in small enough pieces to make a star shape on the cookie.

Step 2: Spread your icing, whipped cream or Cool Whip on the cookies.

Step 3: Place the strawberries and blueberries around the cookies to make a star shape.

Step 4: Enjoy!



Make a 4th of July Rocket!



You will need:

- Toilet paper tube or cut a paper towel tube in half
- Red, white and blue ribbon or construction paper cut into strips
- Paint brushes
- White construction paper to paint on
- Glue
- Scissors
- Red, white and blue paint

Steps:

1) Draw a circle on the white construction paper and cut it out - make sure to cut out a small wedge.



2) Paint the circle and toilet paper tube however you would like.

3) Make the circle into a cone shape and glue it together.



4) Glue the cone onto the top of the toilet paper tube.



5) Attach the ribbons and now you have a rocket!
